ROSÉ AT BARNARD GRIFFIN —

We're very serious about this festive and flavorful dry wine. Quality Rosé starts with grapes grown specifically for this purpose. Our Rosé is a deliberate result of careful winemaking, not an incidental byproduct of red production. Our Rosé is conceived in the vineyard at pruning and matured to be crisp, lean and fruity - it is the most winningest wine at the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, **ever**.

VINTAGE 2025 —

A steady spring led into warm summer days and the cool evenings that we rely on to preserve natural acidity, aromatic intensity, freshness and ageability. Moderate temperatures through much of harvest allowed fruit to arrive at the winery in outstanding condition. The resulting wines show vibrant varietal character, refined tannin structure, concentrated fruit expression, and impressive natural balance.

Our regions climate continues to make sustainable winegrowing a natural extension of the area itself. Our dry shrub-step environment significantly reduces disease pressure, limiting the need for many vineyard inputs. Consistent sunshine, low annual rainfall, and dramatic day-to-night temperature swings create ideal conditions for producing wines with intensity, freshness, and site expression.

The 2025 vintage reflects both the resilience of Washington growers and the remarkable consistency of the region. These wines showcase purity, energy, and a sense of place that continue to make Washington State one of the most exciting and dependable wine regions in the world.
