peach, guava and cava cava orange - balanced acidity with notes of honeyed pear

Situated in the rain shadow of the Cascade Mountains, the Columbia Valley accounts for 99% of viniferous acreage in Washington. The rainshadow, along with the cataclysmic events of the Missoula Floods at the end of the last ice age contribute to the diversity of soil found throughout the valley. Most vineyard sites are situated below floodwater, where soil is sandy with loess over basalt, created well-aerated and terrifically suited soil for viticulture. The Columbia Valley has warm, dry temperatures and ample sunlight, allowing for a high amount of control in grape development.
